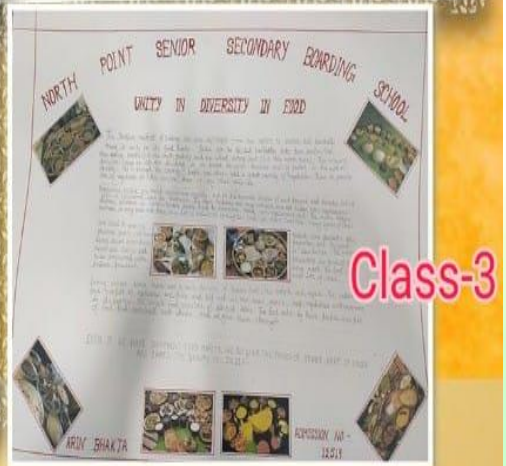
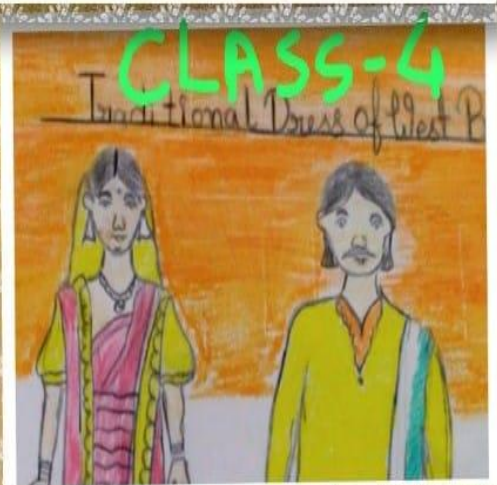
CELEBRATION OF REPUBLIC DAY - 2021

Theme - WE THE PEOPLE

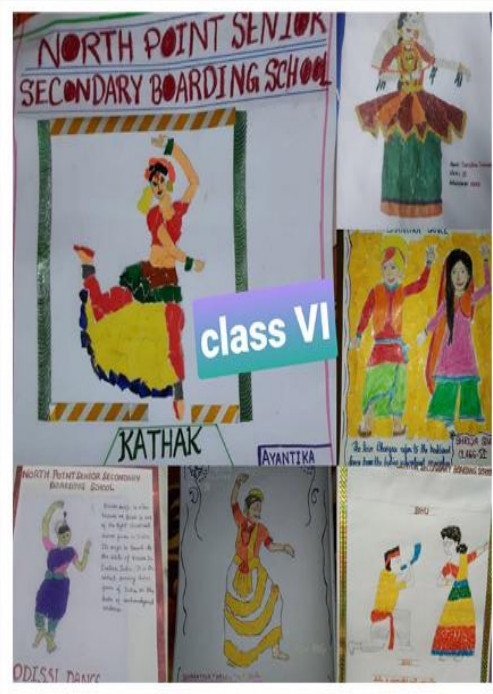
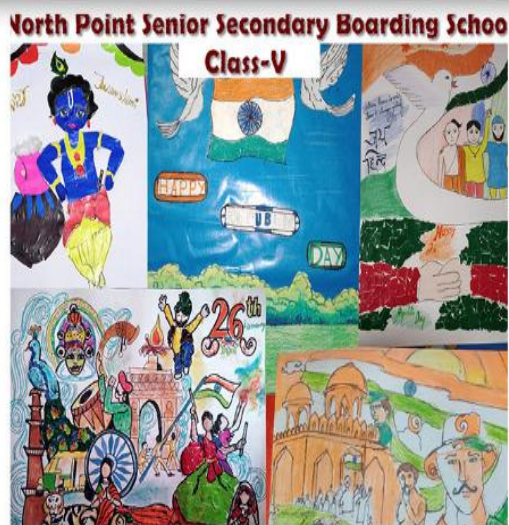

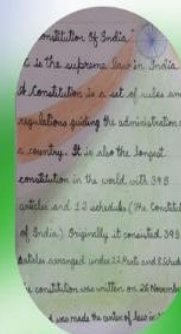
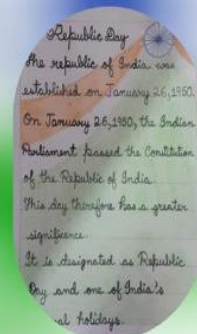


WE THE PEOPLE OF INDIA FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS AND DUTIES
