Ans) All living things need air to breathe. There is no life on Earth without air.

4) What happens if we breathe impure air?

Ans) Breathing impure air can make us sick, so we must breathe fresh air.

Ans) Planting more and more trees around us can keep the air clean and fresh. Plants give out oxygen and take in carbon dioxide during the process of making food called photosynthesis.
