* We use "an" before words that begin with a vowel (a, e, i, o, u) eg:- an Orange, an Egg

* We use "a" before words that begin consonants.

a Book, a Pen, a Cat

* Some words though they begin with a vowel but when we pronounce or say them we get a consonant sound. So we use "a" with those words.

eg. a Uniform, a United team,
a Unicorn, a One rupee note,
a One eyed man.

* Honest, hour, honour though these words begin with "h" which is a consonant but we say o

sound comes out which is a vowel. So we use "an" before the word.

eg:- an Honest man, an Hour, an Honour.
